1. Jesus Showed Us Compassion.

- *When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.*

—Matthew 9:36 (NIV)

- *Soon afterward, Jesus went to a town called Nain, and his disciples and a large crowd went along with him. As he approached the town gate, a dead person was being carried out—the only son of his mother, and she was a widow. And a large crowd from the town was with her. When the Lord saw her, his heart went out to her and he said, “Don’t cry.” Then he went up and touched the bier they were carrying him on, and the bearers stood still. He said, “Young man, I say to you, get up!” The dead man sat up and began to talk, and Jesus gave him back to his mother.*

—Luke 7:13-15 (NIV)

2. Jesus Lets Out Anger.

- *Go ahead and be angry. You do well to be angry—but don’t use your anger as fuel for revenge. And don’t stay angry. Don’t go to bed angry. Don’t give*

the Devil that kind of foothold in your life.

—Ephesians 4:26 (MSG)

- *And Jesus entered into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the money-changers, and the seats of them that sold the doves.*

—Matthew 21:12 (ERV)

- *Seeing a fig tree by the road, he went up to it but found nothing on it except leaves. Then he said to it, “May you never bear fruit again! Immediately the tree withered.*

—Matthew 21:19 (NIV)

- *You brood of vipers, how can you who are evil say anything good? For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of.*

3. Jesus Showed Sadness.

- *Jesus wept.*

—John 11:35 (NIV)

- *When Jesus saw her weeping, and the Jews who had come along with her also weeping, he was deeply moved in spirit and troubled.*

—John 11:33 (NIV)

- *When Jesus heard what had happened, he withdrew by boat privately to a solitary place. Hearing of this, the crowds followed him on foot from the towns.*

—Matthew 14:13 (NIV)

4. Jesus Models Love.

- *Yes, God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him would not be lost but have eternal life.*

—John 3:16 (ERV)

- *My beloved friends, let us continue to love each other since love comes from God. Everyone who loves is born of God and experiences a relationship with God. The person who refuses to love doesn't know the first thing about God, because God is love— so you can't know him if you don't love. This is how God showed his love for us: God sent his only Son into the world so we might live through him. This is the kind of love we are talking about—not that we once upon a time loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to clear away our sins and the damage they've done to our relationship with God.*

—1 John 4:7-10 (MSG)

- *Jesus looked at him and loved him. “One thing you lack,” he said. “Go, sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me.”*

—Mark 10:21 (NIV)

- *One of the followers was next to Jesus and was leaning close to him. This was the one Jesus loved very much.*

—John 13:23 (ERV)

- *Jesus answered, “All who love me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them. My Father and I will come to them and live with them.*

—John 14:23 (ERV)

- *If we say we live in God, we must live the way Jesus lived.*

—1 John 2:6 (ERV)
