


Jesus On Divorce



When Jesus had finished saying these things, he left Galilee and went down to the region of Judea east of the Jordan River. Large crowds followed him there, and he healed their sick. Some Pharisees came to him to test him. They asked, “Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any and every reason?”

—Matthew 19:1-3 (NLT)

“It has been said, ‘Anyone who divorces his wife must give her a certificate of divorce.’ But I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, makes her the victim of adultery, and anyone who marries a divorced woman commits adultery.

—Matthew 5:31-32 (NIV)

Some Observations On Divorce:

1. The Old Testament Law Protected Women.

- *Suppose a woman was divorced by her... husband... He wrote out divorce papers, gave them to her, and sent her away.*

—Deuteronomy 24:1 (CEV)

2. The Old Testament Had Three “Grounds”.

Cause #1- Unfaithfulness.

- *Suppose a woman was divorced by her... husband because he found something disgraceful about her.*

—Deuteronomy 24:1 (CEV)

Causes #2 & #3- Abuse & Neglect.

- *If he marries another woman, he must not deprive the first one of her food, clothing and marital rights. If he does not provide her with these three things, she is to go free.*

—Exodus 21:10-11 (NIV)

3. Divorce Had Become The Hot Topic.

- *Suppose a woman was divorced by her... husband because he found something disgraceful (any cause of disgrace) about her.*

—Deuteronomy 24:1 (CEV)

- *Some Pharisees came and tried to trap him with this question: "Should a man be allowed to divorce his wife for just any reason?"*

—Matthew 19:3 (NLT)

- *Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly.*

—Matthew 1:19 (NIV)

- *Then why did Moses say in the law that a man could give his wife a written notice of divorce and send her away?*

—Matthew 19:7 (NLT)

4. Jesus Was A Champion Of The Powerless.

- *Jesus replied, "Moses permitted divorce only as a concession to your hard hearts, but it was not what God had originally intended. And I tell you this, whoever divorces his wife and marries someone else commits adultery— unless his wife has been unfaithful.*

—Matthew 19:8-9 (NLT)

- *But if the husband or wife who isn't a believer insists on leaving, let them go. In such cases the believing husband or wife is no longer bound to the other.*

—1 Corinthians 7:15 (NLT)

5. Divorce Is NOT The Unforgivable Sin.

- *I gave faithless Israel her certificate of divorce and sent her away because of all her (unfaithfulness).*

—Jeremiah 3:8 (NIV)

- *In all things God works for the good of those who love him and are fitting into his plans.*

—Romans 8:28 (TLB)

Follow Through Step:

Pray for the people you know who have been impacted by divorce that they would find healing, mercy and redemption. And if that's you- we are praying you will begin experiencing healing, mercy and redemption.
