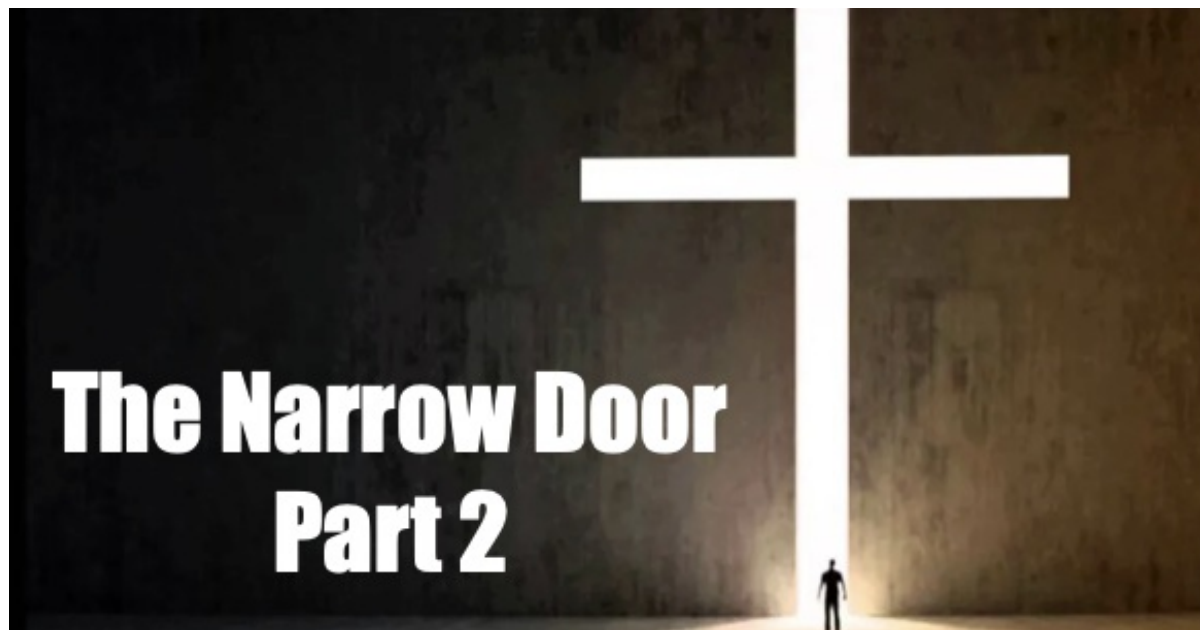

The Door Is Narrow, But It's Wide Open



Jesus went through the towns and villages, teaching as he went, always pressing on toward Jerusalem. Someone asked him, "Lord, will only a few be saved?" He replied, "Work hard to enter the narrow door to God's Kingdom, for many will try to enter but will fail."

What's The Deal With The Narrow Door?

1. It's Not Narrow Because God Is Stingy.

** He replied, "Work hard to enter the narrow door to God's Kingdom, for many will try to enter but will fail." When the master of the house has locked the door, it will be too late. You will stand outside knocking and pleading, 'Lord, open the door for us!' But he will reply, 'I don't know you or where you come from.'*

—Luke 13:25 (NLT)

- *So, no matter what I say, what I believe, and what I do, I'm bankrupt without love.*

—1 Corinthians 13:3 (MSG)

- *Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross, and follow me. If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake, you will save it."*

—Matthew 16:24-25 (NLT)

2. The Door Will Close One Day.

- *When the master of the house has locked the door, it will be too late. You will stand outside knocking and pleading, 'Lord, open the door for us!' But he will reply, 'I don't know you or where you come from.' Then you will say, 'But we ate and drank with you, and you taught in our streets.' And he will reply, 'I tell you, I don't know you'*

or where you come from. Get away from me, all you who do evil.’ “There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth, for you will see Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and all the prophets in the Kingdom of God, but you will be thrown out. And people will come from all over the world— from east and west, north and south— to take their places in the Kingdom of God. And note this: Some who seem least important now will be the greatest then, and some who are the greatest now will be least important then.”

—Luke 13:26-30 (NLT)

- *It is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment.*

—Hebrews 9:27 (ESV)

- *He suffered physical death, but he was raised to life in the Spirit. So he went and preached to the spirits in prison— those who disobeyed God long ago when God waited patiently while Noah was building his boat.*

—1 Peter 3:18-20 (NLT)

3. Hell Is A Shadowy Subject.

- *Then God looked over all he had made, and he saw that it was very good!*

—Genesis 1:31 (NLT)

- *And the tongue is a flame of fire. It is full of wickedness, and poisons every part of the body. And the tongue is set on fire by hell itself and can turn our whole lives into a blazing flame of destruction and disaster.*

—James 3:6 (TLB)

- *Adam’s one sin brings condemnation for everyone,*

but Christ's one act of righteousness brings a right relationship with God and new life for everyone. Because one person disobeyed God, many became sinners. But because one other person obeyed God, many will be made righteous... So just as sin ruled over all people and brought them to death, now God's wonderful grace rules instead, giving us right standing with God and resulting in eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

—Romans 5:18-21 (NLT)

- *We are made right in God's sight when we trust in Jesus Christ to take away our sins. And we all can be saved in this same way, no matter who we are or what we have done.*

—Romans 3:22 (NLT)

Follow Through Step:

Spend some time reflecting on what you believe about the concept of hell. Who goes there? What happens to them and for how long? And ask yourself why you believe what you do. If you'd like to do a deep dive into this subject watch the movie, *Hell And Mr. Fudge* (available on Amazon Prime Video) and/or read *The Great Divorce* by CS Lewis or *Love Wins* by Rob Bell to see how complex these questions really are.
