1. Hope is hard.

- When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, “Do you want to be made well?”
John 5:6 NKJV
- Why am I discouraged? Why is my heart so sad? I will put my hope in God! I will praise him again— my Savior and my God!
Psalm 42:11
- And his name will be the hope of all the world.” Matthew 12:21
