1. Offer Them Grace.

- *I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples.*

- *Accept each other just as Christ has accepted you so that God will be given glory.*
—Romans 15:7 (NLT)
- *Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.*

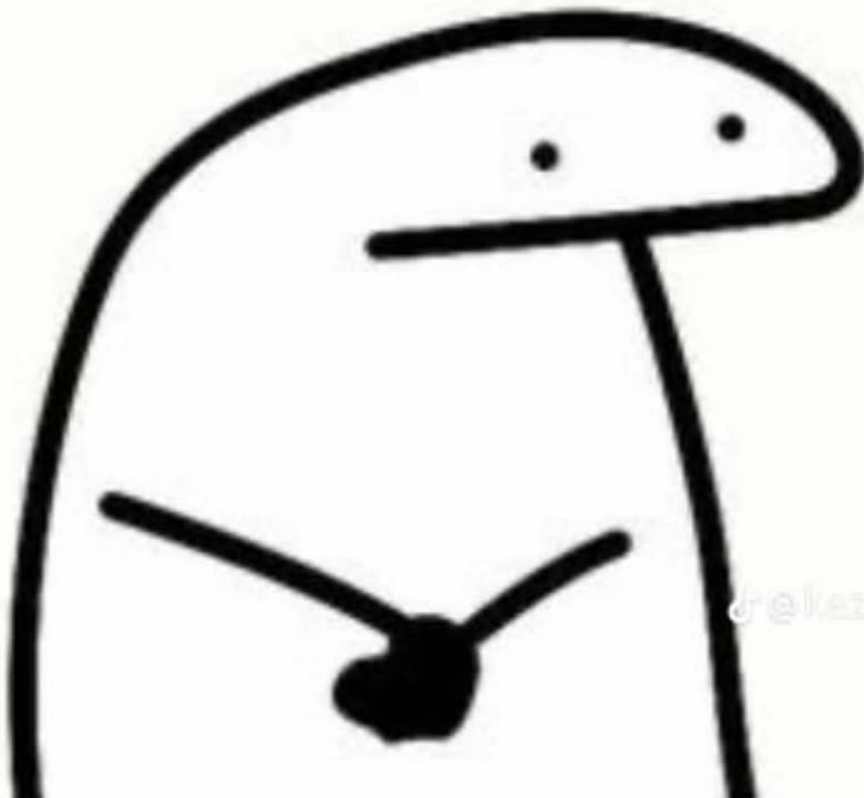

2. Offer Them Truth.

- *You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.*

—John 8:32 (NIV)

3. Offer Them Time.

Follow Through Step:

Pray for the “as-is” people in your life and while you wait patiently for God to change them don’t forget that you are also an “as-is” person who Jesus is also working on.
