What Exactly Is Jesus Claiming?

1. He Is The Glory Of God.

- *Jesus made these statements while he was teaching in the section of the Temple known as the Treasury. But he was not arrested.*

—John 8:20 (NLT)

- *Then the cloud covered the Tabernacle, and the glory of the Lord filled the Tabernacle. Moses could*

no longer enter the Tabernacle because the cloud had settled down over it, and the glory of the Lord filled the Tabernacle... So the cloud of the Lord was over the tabernacle by day, and fire was in the cloud by night, in the sight of all the Israelites during all their travels.

—Exodus 40:34-38 (NLT)

- *When Solomon finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the Lord filled the temple. The priests could not enter the temple of the Lord because the glory of the Lord filled it.*

—2 Chronicles 7:1-2 (NLT)

- *Then the glory of the LORD departed from over the threshold of the temple.*

2. He Is The Blast Shield Of God.

- *We proclaim to you the one who existed from the beginning, whom we have heard and seen. We saw him with our own eyes and touched him with our own hands. He is the Word of life.*

—1 John 1:1 (NLT)

- *So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son.*

—John 1:14 (NLT)

- *Philip said, "Lord, show us the Father, and we will be satisfied." Jesus replied, "Have I been with you*

*all this time, Philip, and yet you still don't know
who I am? Anyone who has seen me has seen the
Father! So why are you asking me to show him to
you?*
