Rivers of Living Water

John 7:25-44

After his brothers left for the festival, Jesus also went, though secretly, staying out of public view. The Jewish leaders tried to find him at the festival and kept asking if anyone had seen him.

—John 7:10-11 (NLT)

Observations On Rivers Of Living Water:

1. Living Water Was Part Of The Feast.

- *With joy you will drink deeply from the fountain of salvation! In that wonderful day you will sing: “Thank the Lord! Praise his name! Tell the nations what he has done.”*

—Isaiah 12:2-6 (NLT)

- *On the last day, the climax of the festival, Jesus stood and shouted to the crowds, “Anyone who is thirsty may come to me! Anyone who believes in me may come and drink! For the Scriptures declare, ‘Rivers of living water will flow from his heart.’”*

—John 7:37-38 (NLT)

- *And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature.*

—2 Peter 1:4 (NLT)

- *The Word became flesh and made his tabernacles among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.*

—John 1:14 (NLT)

- *And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Behold! God’s tabernacle is now among the people, and he will tabernacle with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. ‘He will wipe every tear from their eyes.
