After his brothers left for the festival, Jesus also went, though secretly, staying out of public view. The Jewish leaders tried to find him at the festival and kept asking if

anyone had seen him.

Observations On Rivers Of Living Water:

1. Living Water Was Part Of The Feast.

- *On the last day, the climax of the festival, Jesus stood and shouted to the crowds, “Anyone who is thirsty may come to me! Anyone who believes in me may come and drink! For the Scriptures declare, ‘Rivers of living water will flow from his heart.’”*

—John 7:37-38 (NLT)

2. This Gift Requires Major Glory.

- *(When he said “living water,” he was speaking of the Spirit, who would be given to everyone believing in him. But the Spirit had not yet been given, because Jesus had not yet entered into his glory.)*


—John 7:39 (NLT)

- *The Word became flesh and made his tabernacle among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.*

—John 1:14 (NLT)

- *As he slept, he dreamed of a stairway that reached from the earth up to heaven. And he saw the angels of God going up and down the stairway.*

—Genesis 28:12 (NLT)



- *As they approached, Jesus said, “Now here is a genuine son of Israel—a man of complete integrity.” “How do you know about me?” Nathanael asked. Jesus replied, “I could see you under the fig tree before Philip found you.” Then Nathanael exclaimed, “Rabbi, you are the Son of God—the King of Israel!” Jesus asked him, “Do you believe this just because I told you I had seen you under the fig tree? You will see greater things than this.” Then he said, “I tell you the truth, you will all see heaven open and the angels of God going up and down on the Son of Man, the one who is the stairway between heaven and earth.*

—John 1:47-51 (NLT)

3. This Gift Requires Major Sacrifice.

- *The Lord said to Moses, “Walk out in front of the people. Take your staff, the one you used when you struck the water of the Nile, and call some of the elders of Israel to join you. I will stand before you on the rock at Mount Sinai. Strike the rock, and water will come gushing out. Then the people will be able to drink.” So Moses struck the rock as he*

was told, and water gushed out as the elders looked on.

—Exodus 17:5-6 (NLT)

- *My people have committed two sins: They have forsaken me, the spring of living water, and have dug their own wells, broken wells that cannot hold water.*

—Jeremiah 2:13 (NIV)

- *And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering.*

—Romans 8:17 (NLT)

- *Let anyone who is thirsty come. Let anyone who desires drink freely from the water of life.*

—Revelation 22:17 (NLT)

Follow Through Step:

Spend some time reflecting on what you use to try to satiate the thirst that all of feel deep inside. What's your “comfort” when life starts to remind you of just how thirsty you really are?
