

Lessons From Jesus' Final Night:

1. The Great Rescue.

- *And I will cause hostility between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring. He will strike your head, and you will strike his heel."*

—Genesis 3:15 (NLT)

2. The Shocking Cost Of Our Rescue.

- *He took Peter, James, and John with him, and he became deeply troubled and distressed. He told them, "My soul is crushed with grief to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me."*

—Mark 14:33-34 (NLT)

3. The Courage/Love Of The Rescuer.

- *“Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.” ...And being in anguish, he prayed more earnestly, and his sweat was like drops of blood falling to the ground.*

—Luke 22:42-44 (NLT)

- *Your cup is filled to the brim with distress and desolation... You will drain that cup of terror to the very bottom.*

—Ezekiel 23:33-34 (NLT)

- *I looked at the earth, and it was empty and had no shape. I looked at the sky, and its light was gone.*

—Jeremiah 4:23 (NLT)

- *In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was formless and empty; darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. And God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light.*

4. The Results Of God’s Plan.

- *He canceled the debt, which listed all the rules we failed to follow. He took away that record with its rules and nailed it to the cross. God stripped the spiritual rulers and powers of their authority. With the cross, he won the victory and showed the world that they were powerless.*

- *Jesus knew that his mission was now complete, and... he said, “It is finished!” Then he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.*

—John 19:28-30 (NLT)

- *See, I have taken the terrible cup from your hands. You will drink no more of my fury.*

—Isaiah 51:22 (NLT)
