THE MAN BEHIND THE METAPHORS

Now at the festival the Jewish leaders were watching for Jesus and asking, "Where is he?" Among the crowds there was widespread whispering about him.

—John 7:12-13 (NIV)

Who Is Jesus? Three Important Questions:

1. Who Does He Think He Is?

- *Are you greater than our father Abraham? He died, and so did the prophets. Who do you think you are?"*

—John 8:53 (NLT)

- *Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, before Abraham was even born, I am!"*

—John 8:58 (NLT)

- *Now go, for I am sending you to Pharaoh. You must lead my people Israel out of Egypt.*

—Exodus 3:10 (NLT)

- *God replied to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM. Say this to the people of Israel: I AM has sent me to you... Say this to the people of Israel: Yahweh, the God of your ancestors—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob—has sent me to you. This is my eternal name, my name to remember for all generations.*

—Exodus 3:13-14 (NLT)

2. Who Do They Think He Is?

- *The Father and I are one." Once again the people picked up stones to kill him. Jesus said, "At my Father's direction I have done many good works. For which one are you going to stone me?" They replied, "We're stoning you not for any good work, but for blasphemy! You, a mere man, claim to be God."*

—John 8:30-33 (NLT)

- *The people retorted, “You Samaritan devil! Didn’t we say all along that you were possessed by a demon?”*

—John 8:48 (NLT)

- *The people said, “Now we know you are possessed by a demon. Even Abraham and the prophets died, but you say, ‘Anyone who obeys my teaching will never die!’ Are you greater than our father Abraham? He died, and so did the prophets. Who do you think you are?”*

—John 8:52-53 (NLT)

3. Who Do I Think He Is?

- *Jesus... asked his disciples, “Who do people say that the Son of Man is?” “Well,” they replied, “some say John the Baptist, some say Elijah, and others say Jeremiah or one of the other prophets.” Then he asked them, “But who do you say I am?”*

—Matthew 16:13-15 (NLT)

Follow Through Step:

Spend the week with this question: who do you say that Jesus is? Is He “the” Lord & Savior or is He “your” Lord & Savior? How does that impact your everyday life?
