# Honoring Women Like Jesus Did...

## 1. The Ancestors.

- *Judah was the father of Perez and Zerah (whose mother was Tamar)... Salmon was the father of Boaz (whose mother was Rahab). Boaz was the father of Obed (whose mother was Ruth). Obed was the father of Jesse. Jesse was the father of King David. David was the father of Solomon (whose mother was Bathsheba, the widow of Uriah).*

—Matthew 1:3-6 (NLT)

## 2. The Outcasts.

- *Then the frightened woman, trembling at the realization of what had happened to her, came and fell to her knees in front of him and told him what she had done. And he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace. Your suffering is over."*

—Mark 5:33-34 (NLT)

- *The woman said, "I know that Messiah" (called Christ) "is coming. When he comes, he will explain everything to us." Then Jesus declared, "I, the one speaking to you—I am he."*
