As Jesus was walking along, he saw a man who had been blind from birth.

—John 9:1 (NLT)

This Story Teaches Us To...

1. Break Through Either/Or Thinking.

- *His followers asked him, “Teacher, whose sin caused this man to be born blind- his own sin or his parents’ sin?”*

—John 9:2 (NCV)

- *Jesus said, “You’re asking the wrong question. You’re looking for someone to blame. There is no such cause- effect here. Look instead for what God can do.*

—John 9:3 (MES)

- *In this world you will have trouble, but be brave! I have defeated the world.”*

—John 16:33 (NCV)

2. Follow Jesus’ Directions.

- *“But while I am here in the world, I am the light of the world.” Then he spit on the ground, made mud with the saliva, and spread the mud over the blind man’s eyes.*

—John 9:5-6 (NLT)

- *Then he told the man, “Go and wash in the Pool of Siloam.”... So the man went, washed, and came back seeing.*

—John 9:7 (NCV)

3. Look Beyond What Others Won’t See.

- *His neighbors and others who knew him as a blind beggar asked each other, “Isn’t this the man who used to sit and beg?” Some said he was, and others said, “No, he just looks like him!” But the beggar*

kept saying, "Yes, I am the same one!"

—John 9:8-9 (NCV)

- *The Jewish leaders still refused to believe the man had been blind and could now see, so they called in his parents.*

—John 9:18 (NLT)

- *"I don't know whether he is a sinner," the man replied. "But I know this: I was blind, and now I can see!"*

—John 9:25 (NLT)

4. Put Your Trust In Jesus.

- *Jesus heard that they had thrown him out, and went and found him. He asked him, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" The man said, "Point him out to me, sir, so that I can believe in him." Jesus said, "You're looking right at him. Don't you recognize my voice?" "Master, I believe," the man said, and worshiped him.*

—John 9:35-38 (NLT)

- *Jesus then said, "I came into the world to bring everything into the clear light of day, making all the distinctions clear, so that those who have never seen will see, and those who have made a great pretense of seeing will be exposed as blind."*

—John 9:39 (MES)

Follow Through Step:

Spend some time reflecting on what you'd like to be able to see in your own life. What would you ask Jesus to help you be able to finally see in your life?
