Following The Year(s) Of Jesus #76 The Conclusion Of The Sermon On The Mount



One day as he saw the crowds gathering, Jesus went up on the mountainside and sat down. His disciples gathered around him, and he began to teach them.

—Matthew 5:1-2 (NLT)

What Have We Learned?

1. Jesus Taught With Real Authority.

- *As Jesus was walking through the Temple area, the leading priests, the teachers of religious law, and the elders came up to him. They demanded, “By what authority are you doing all these things? Who gave you the right to do them?”*

—Mark 11:27-28 (NLT)

- *When Jesus had finished saying these things, the crowds were amazed at his teaching, for he taught with real authority—quite unlike their teachers of religious law.*

—Matthew 7:28-29 (NLT)

- *You have heard that our ancestors were told, ‘You must not murder. If you commit murder, you are subject to judgment.’ But I say to you...*

—Matthew 5:21-22 (NLT)

2. There Are Two Ways.

- *Go in through the narrow gate. The gate to destruction is wide, and the road that leads there is easy to follow... Watch out for false prophets! They dress up like sheep, but inside they are wolves who have come to attack you... A good tree produces good fruit, and a bad tree produces bad fruit... Anyone who hears and obeys these teachings of mine is like a wise person who built a house on solid rock.*

—Matthew 7:13-24 (CEV)

- *When you give to someone in need, don't do as the hypocrites do... When you pray, don't be like the hypocrites...*

—Matthew 6:1-5 (NLT)

- *But I warn you— unless your righteousness is better than the righteousness of the teachers of religious law and the Pharisees, you will never enter the Kingdom of Heaven!*

—Matthew 5:20 (NLT)

- *Not everyone who calls out to me, 'Lord! Lord!' will enter the Kingdom of Heaven. Only those who actually do the will of my Father in heaven will enter. On judgment day many will say to me, 'Lord! Lord! We prophesied in your name and cast out demons in your name and performed many miracles in your name.' But I will reply, 'I never knew you. Get away from me, you who break God's laws.'*

—Matthew 7:21-23 (NLT)

- *For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things*

he planned for us long ago.

—Ephesians 2:8-10 (NIV)

- *We are made right in God's sight when we trust in Jesus Christ to take away our sins. And we all can be saved in this same way, no matter who we are or what we have done.*

—Romans 3:22 (NLT)

3. We Are To Practice, Practice, Practice.

- *Everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash.*

—Matthew 7:24-27 (NIV)

- *Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.*

—Matthew 5:48 (NIV)

- *I have given them the glory you gave me.*

—John 17:22 (NLT)

- *Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, the tax collectors and the prostitutes will enter the kingdom of God before you do."*

—Matthew 21:31 (NCV)
