Observations On Gratitude

1. Jesus Sees You.

- *As he entered a village there, ten men with leprosy stood at a distance, crying out, “Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!” When he saw them, he said, “Go, show yourselves to the priests.”*

—Luke 17:12-14 (NLT)

- *She gave this name to the Lord who spoke to her: “You are the God who sees me,” for she said, “I have now seen the One who sees me.”*

—Genesis 16:13 (NIV)

- *What is the price of five sparrows— two copper coins? Yet God does not forget a single one of them. And the very hairs on your head are all numbered. So don’t be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows.*

—Luke 12:6-7 (NLT)

2. Obedience Generally Precedes Healing.

- *The eyes of the Lord search the whole earth in order to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him.*

—2 Chronicles 16:9 (NLT)

- *He looked at them and said, “Go show yourselves to the priests.” And as they went, they were cleansed of their leprosy.*

—Luke 17:14 (NLT)

3. Gratitude Saves Us.

- *Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and don't forget to thank him for all he has done. If you do this you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.*

—*Philippians 4:6-7 (NLT)*

- *One of them, when he saw that he was cleansed, came back to Jesus, shouting, "Praise God!" He fell to the ground at Jesus' feet, thanking him for what he had done. This man was a Samaritan. Jesus asked, "Didn't I cleanse ten men? Where are the other nine? Has no one returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" And Jesus said to the man, "Stand up and go. Your faith has healed you."*
