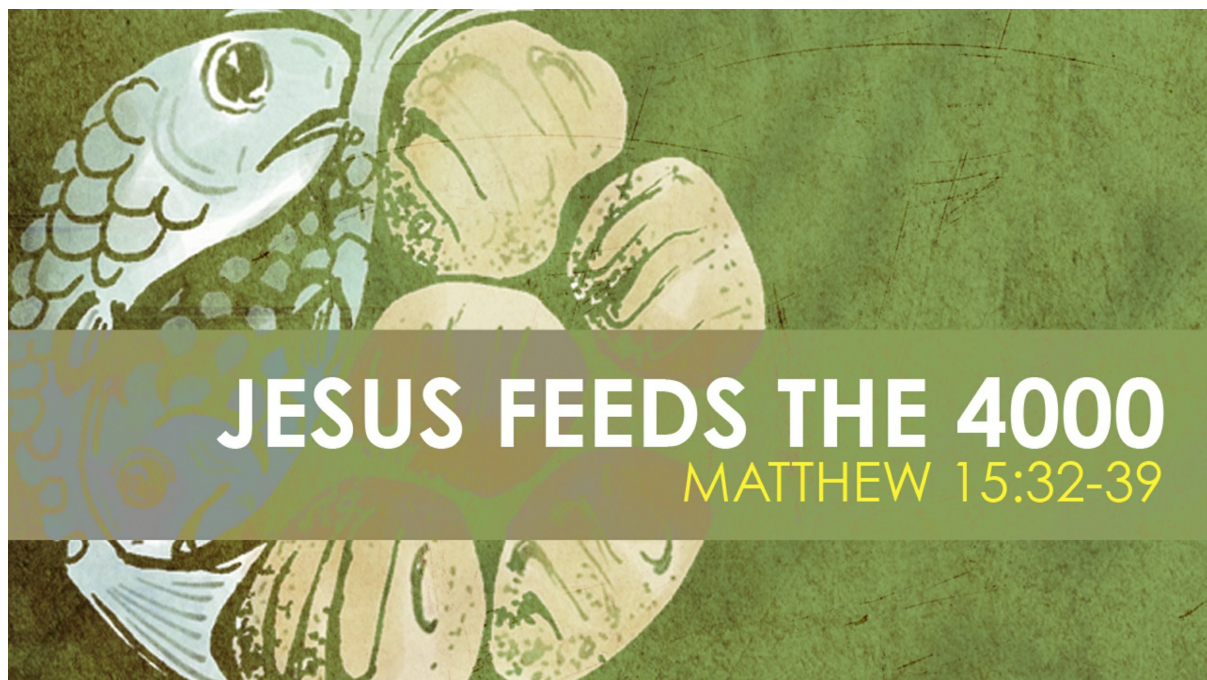

Following The Year(s) Of ^Jesus #132 Jesus Feeds The Multitudes- Again



Jesus returned to the Sea of Galilee and climbed a hill and sat down. A vast crowd brought to him people who were lame, blind, crippled, those who couldn't speak, and many others. They laid them before Jesus, and he healed them all. The crowd was amazed! Those who hadn't been able to speak were talking, the crippled were made well, the lame were walking, and the blind could see again! And they praised the God of Israel. —*Matthew 15:29-31 (NLT)*

Why Feed Multitudes Again?

1. He Always Responds To Genuine Need.

- *Jesus called his disciples and told them, "I feel sorry for these people. They have been here with me for three days, and they have nothing left to eat. If I send them home hungry, they will faint along the way. For some of them have come a long distance."*
—*Mark 8:1-3 (NLT)*

- *His disciples replied, "How are we supposed to find enough food to feed them out here in the wilderness?" Jesus asked, "How much bread do you have?" "Seven loaves," they replied. So Jesus told all the people to sit down on the ground. Then he took the seven loaves, thanked God for them, and broke them into pieces. He gave them to his disciples, who distributed the bread to the crowd. A few small fish were found, too, so Jesus also blessed these and told the disciples to distribute them.*
—*Mark 8:4-7 (NLT)*

- *They ate as much as they wanted. Afterward, the disciples picked up seven large baskets of leftover food. There were about 4,000 in the crowd that day, and Jesus sent them home after they had eaten. Immediately after this, he got into a boat with his disciples and crossed over to the region of Dalmanutha.*
—*Mark 8:8-10 (NLT)*

2. He Never Responds To Demands.

- *When the Pharisees heard that Jesus had arrived, they came and started to argue with him. Testing him, they demanded that he show them a miraculous sign from heaven to prove his authority.*
—Mark 8:11(NLT)

- *When he heard this, he sighed deeply in his spirit and said, “Why do these people keep demanding a miraculous sign? I tell you the truth, I will not give this generation any such sign.” So he got back into the boat and left them, and he crossed to the other side of the lake.*
—Mark 8:12-13 (NLT)

- *It is far too small a thing for you to be my servant to... bring back those of Israel I have kept. I will also make you a light for the (Nations), that you may bring my salvation to the ends of the earth.*
—Isaiah 49:6 (NIV)

- *Only an evil, adulterous generation would demand a miraculous sign, but the only sign I will give them is the sign of the prophet Jonah.” Then Jesus left them and went away.*
—Mark 8:12-13 (NLT)

3. Be Careful Where You Put Your Faith.

- *After they crossed to the other side of the lake, the disciples discovered they had forgotten to bring any bread. “Watch out!” Jesus warned them. “Beware of the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees.”*
—Matthew 16:5-6 (NLT)

- *At this they began to argue with each other because they hadn’t brought any bread. Jesus knew what they were saying, so he said, “Why are you arguing about having no bread? Don’t you know or understand even yet? Are your hearts too hard to take it in? ‘You have eyes— can’t you see? You have ears— can’t you hear?’ Don’t you remember*

anything at all?"

—Mark 8:16-19 (NLT)

- *When I fed the 5,000 with five loaves of bread, how many baskets of leftovers did you pick up afterward?" "Twelve," they said. "And when I fed the 4,000 with seven loaves, how many large baskets of leftovers did you pick up "Seven," they said. "Don't you understand yet?" he asked them.*

—Mark 8:19-21 (NLT)

- *Why can't you understand that I'm not talking about bread? So again I say, 'Beware of the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees.'" Then at last they understood that he wasn't speaking about the yeast in bread, but about the deceptive teaching of the Pharisees and Sadducees.*

—Matthew 16:11-12 (NLT)

Follow Through Step:

Spend some time reflecting on whose spiritual "yeast" you are fermenting in your own being. Is it the yeast of the Kingdom or is someone/something else's yeast that's working it's way through you?
