Following The Year Of Jesus #32 Jesus Heals A Paralytic Party Crasher

When Jesus returned to Capernaum several days later, the news spread quickly that he was back home. Soon the house where he was staying was so packed with visitors that there was no more room, even outside the door.

-Mark 2:1-2 (NLT)

Who Was Shocked By This Story?

1. The Party Crashers.

While he was preaching God's word to them, four men arrived carrying a paralyzed man on a

mat. They couldn't bring him to Jesus because of the crowd, so they dug a hole through the roof above his head. Then they lowered the man on his mat, right down in front of Jesus.

-Mark 2:2-4 (NLT)

• Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralyzed man, "My child, your sins are forgiven."

—Mark 2:5 (NLT)

• Forgive us for our sins, just as we have forgiven those who sinned against us.

-Matthew 6:12 (NCV)

• Be careful that none of you fails to respond to the grace which God gives, for if he does there can very easily spring up in him a bitter spirit which is not only bad in itself but can also poison the lives of many others.

2. The Readers Of This Story.

Then Jesus turned to the paralyzed man and said, "Stand up, pick up your mat, and go home!" And the man jumped up, grabbed his mat, and walked out through the stunned onlookers. They were all amazed and praised God, exclaiming, "We've never seen anything like this before!"

Follow Through Step #33:

Reflect on the concept of forgiveness. What did/does it take for Jesus to forgive you when you've "sinned". What does it take for you to forgive someone else that has wronged you? What does it take to ask for forgiveness when we've wronged someone else?
