HOUSING

WHEN TO ARRIVE

Arrival is set for Monday, July 20th at Camp Sonshine. Check in is at 10am with a MANDATORY Orientation at 10:30pm. Meals will be provided beginning Monday (lunch) all the way through Friday breakfast. Pick up will be 12pm on Friday July 24th.

COST

The cost is \$300.00 for the entire week which provides lodging, travel, one CW T-shirt, all meals and activities.

Students will not need additional spending money unless they would like to purchase anything from the snack-shack on the campgrounds.

Early Bird Deposit of \$30 will secure your students spot at time of registration from February 1st-April 1st.

After April 1st, the cost bumps up to \$350.00 with \$50 registration deposit. Full balance will be due by Wednesday, June 4th. Sign up today to secure your price of \$300.00

REGISTRATION + FORMS

All forms are required to be filled out completely and for students under the age of 18, a parent/guardian signature is required on their release form. Registration and Permission Form must be turned in with a non-refundable registration deposit. (\$30 between February 1st -April 1st or \$50 April 1st -June 4th). Registration closes June 4th , 2026.
