◆ **I’M SORRY! – Confession**

◆ **THANK YOU! – Gratitude**

“Rooted and built up in Him... strengthened in the faith... overflowing with thankfulness.” (Colossians 2:7)

- Thank You for giving us a foundation that holds when storms come.
- Thank You that depth is possible – even for ordinary, busy people.
- Thank You that Your Word keeps bringing us back when we drift.
- Thank You for quiet roots, formed through small, faithful choices over time.
- Thank You that grounded faith doesn’t mean we won’t bend, only that we won’t break.

◆ SAVE THEM! – Intercession

“The rain came down... the winds blew... yet it did not fall.” (Matthew 7:25)

- Strengthen those walking through sustained storms – grief, stress, sickness, conflict, temptation.
- Draw near to those who feel fragile, scattered, or spiritually undernourished.
- Form our children, teens, and adults into people rooted in Christ—not just influenced by the moment.
- Make our church a place of depth—where Your Word is trusted, practiced, and lived.

◆ DELIVER ME! – Dependence

“God, help me hear Your voice more clearly... and trust it more fully.” (One Prayer)

- Deliver us from building our lives on what is easy and quick.
- Free us from constant distraction and divided attention.
- Teach us to dig – slowly, faithfully – even when it doesn’t feel productive.
- When we’re confused or tempted to drift, return us to Your Word.
- Make us doers of Your Word, not just hearers, so our lives stand when the pressure comes.
