If we look in Philippians 2, we see the unity “app” (Philippians 2:2); the humility “app” (Philippians 2:3); the no-grumbling “app” (Philippians 2:14); and the shine-as-lights “app” (Philippians 2:15).

Multiple “apps” can also be found in the book of Proverbs.

The best thing about the above “apps,” is that we don’t have to wait for someone to offer them on the Internet. All we have to do is open our Bibles and note the hundreds of ways that Scripture applies to our everyday life and living.

Do we have questions as to how to live the Christian life? Then let us be willing to search God’s “apps” found in the Bible (Acts 17:11; 2 Timothy 2:15 KJV) — the answers are there.

Whatever question we might have, the Bible has an “app” for that!
