Most Christians are familiar with Luke 6:38 and many associate that scripture with charitable giving to others. Yet, as I meditated on the Word it occurred to me that Luke 6:38 is most aptly applied to our relationship with our Heavenly Father.

God demonstrated the immense love He has for people when He gave His only begotten Son as propitiation for our sins, so that we now have in Christ the promise of eternal life

with him in heaven, instead of eternal damnation. It is evident therefore, that God loves His children dearly, and He desires no less than our full devotion to him in return. In fact, Jesus expressed this to us very clearly in His command for us to "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength" (Mark 12:30).

However, we must understand that when God



says “all”, *He really does mean ALL*. When we truly love the Lord and give him our actual “all” — i.e., glorifying him in even our smallest victories, looking toward him as the only line of defense in every challenge, and leaving all of our burdens at His feet — then He is well-pleased with us. Likewise, it should also be understood that God knows our hearts better than we know ourselves, so He cannot and shall not be fooled or cheated. There is no aspect of our lives that should be kept from God when we are genuinely giving him our all. Your every thought should begin with, “God said...” and end with “thank you Lord!”

Philippians 2:6-11 (TPT)

6 He existed in the form of God, yet he gave no thought to seizing equality with God as his supreme prize. 7 Instead he emptied himself of his outward glory by reducing himself to the form of a lowly servant. He became human! 8 He humbled himself and became vulnerable, choosing to be revealed as a man and was obedient. He was a perfect example, even in his death—a criminal's death by crucifixion!

9 Because of that obedience, God exalted him and multiplied his greatness! He has now been given the greatest of all names!

10 The authority of the name of Jesus causes every knee to bow in reverence! Everything

“And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel” Genesis 3:15 NKJV.

“Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel” Isaiah 7:14 NKJV.

“Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name Jesus. He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end” Luke 1:30b-33 NKJV.

The promise of a Savior was first given in Genesis with the fall of man. The fall brought death, separation from God. God clearly distinguished between the serpent and Satan, saying to the serpent that because of what he did, allowing Satan to use him, he is

“cursed above every wild animal, condemned above every creature of the field! You will slither on your belly and eat dust all the days of your life!” Genesis 3:14 TPT. But we see Jesus, who as a man, lived for a short time lower than the angels and has now been crowned with glorious honor because of

what he suffered in his death. For it was by God's grace that he experienced death's bitterness on behalf of everyone!" Hebrews 2:8b-9 TPT. 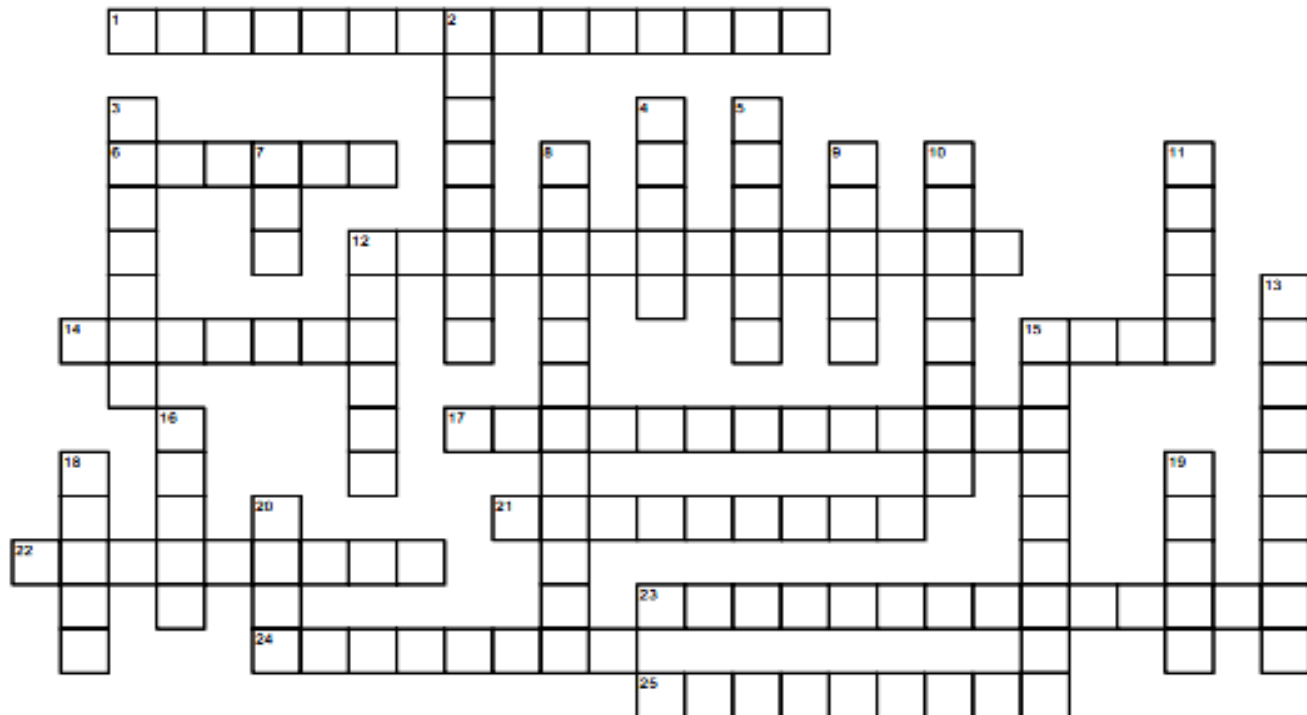

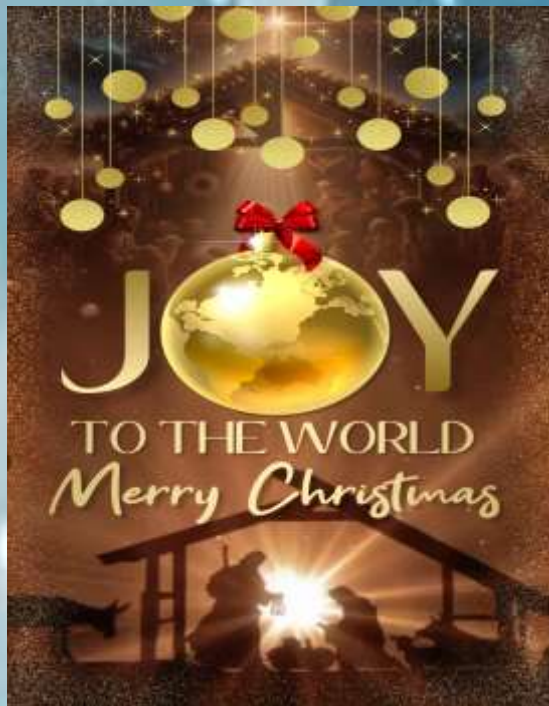

The basis of the Prayer of Salvation comes from Romans 10:9-10, "If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved."

However, I would like to direct you to Ephesians 2:8-9, "For by Grace are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God; Not of works, lest any man should boast."

Grace is mentioned over 100 times in the Bible. Grace is God's unmerited favor and because of God's grace, we receive eternal life and a promise of heaven. Grace is necessary for salvation as we cannot do enough good works or make enough right choices to earn our salvation. The Bible teaches that we are justified by the grace of God (Romans 3:24; Titus 3:7). Justified means declared not guilty. When we accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior, all charges against us are dropped and we are free from sin. When God forgives our sins, the record is wiped clean. It is as if we had never sinned.

A preacher once explained grace with this acronym:

God's - Riches - At - Christ's - Expense

Heavenly Father, In Jesus' name I repent of my sins and open my heart to let Jesus come inside of me. Jesus, You are my Lord and Savior. I believe you died for my sins and you were raised from the dead. Fill me with your Holy Spirit. Thank you Father, for saving me in Jesus' name. Amen.
