

DEVOTED TO ONE ANOTHER

Today we're going to look at what it means to be a people who are truly devoted to one another. In Scripture, devotion is not a casual or occasional commitment—it is steadfast, constant, faithful, and enduring. It's a way of life. My prayer is that we would see we are better together when our lives are deeply integrated, fully devoted to Christ and to one another, not just once a week but in the rhythms of everyday life.

Acts 2:42-47 (NIV) They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. All the believers were together and had everything in common. They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

1. Compelling Presence of the Holy Spirit Among Us

Acts 2:43 (NIV) Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles.

Acts 16:31-34, 40 (NIV) *They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household." Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all the others in his house. At that hour of the night the jailer took them and washed their wounds; then immediately he and all his household were baptized. The jailer brought them into his house and set a meal before them; he was filled with joy because he had come to believe in God—he and his whole household.*

After Paul and Silas came out of the prison, they went to Lydia's house, where they met with the brothers and sisters and encouraged them. Then they left.

2. Deeply Integrated Lives

Philippians 1:8 (NIV) *It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart and, whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me. God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus.*

Philippians 1:21-26 (NIV) *For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. If I am to go on living in the body, this will mean fruitful labor for me. Yet what shall I choose? I do not know! I am torn between the two: I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far; but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body. Convinced of this, I know that I will remain, and I will continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith, so that through my being with you again your boasting in Christ Jesus will abound on account of me.*

3. Real LIFE Devotion to One Another

Romans 10:12 (NIV) *Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality.*
