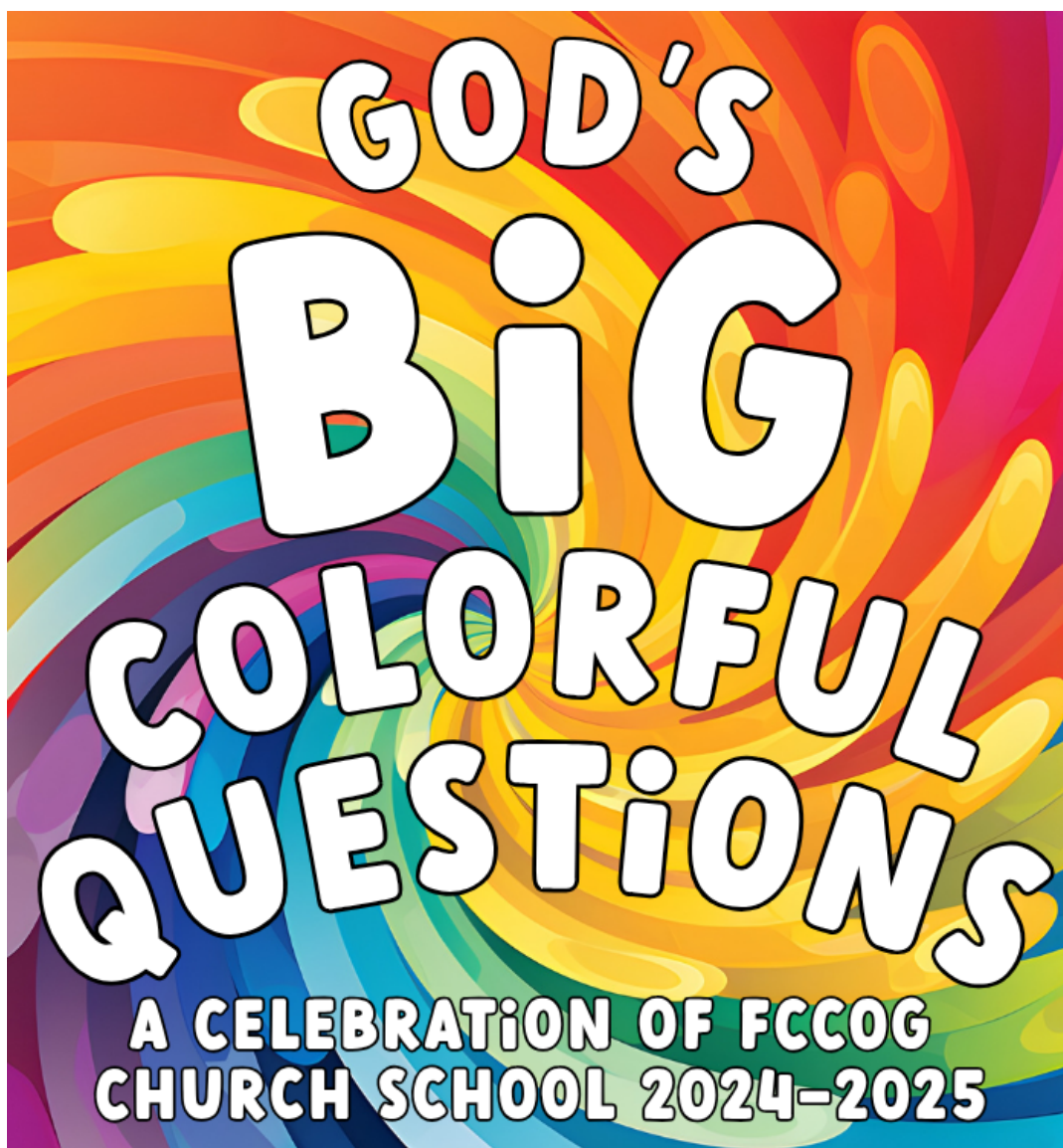

Sensory Sanctuary & Rocking Chairs. Focusing resources located in the back of the Meetinghouse.

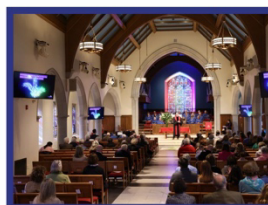
Visual Worship Aids & Live captioning. Found on the monitors.
