#### 5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



##### **IN THE CAR:**

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

What did Jesus say would make us wise? To not just be hearers, but doers of God's word. Just like the wise man who built his house on the rock. Matthew 7:24-27, The Wise and Foolish Builders



##### **HANGING OUT:**

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid if there is anything they have learned in the Bible but have not yet put into practice.

Ask your kid who is someone they know who does what God's word says.



##### **AT DINNER:**

Here are some great discussion starters:

Why is it not enough to just hear God's word without obeying it?

When we live wisely, how does this help us when trials and difficulty come?

Who is an example of someone you know who makes wise choices?



##### **AT BEDTIME:**

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"So, the words spoken by the prophet came true. He has said, 'I will open my mouth and tell stories. I will speak about things that were hidden since the world was made.'" Matthew 13:35 (NIRV)



##### **PARENT TIME:**

What you need to know:

We can help our children see the difference between knowledge and wisdom by pointing to God's word. It is one thing to know what it says, and another thing to obey and do it! Challenge your kid to take one commandment from the Bible and put it into practice this week.
