#### 5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



##### **IN THE CAR:**

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

Who is our neighbor? Everyone we meet. Even people who seem like enemies. We can show mercy and compassion because Jesus did that for us on the cross. Luke 10:30-37, The Good Samaritan



##### **HANGING OUT:**

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid if there is anyone that they know who is difficult to be a good neighbor to. Ask your kid what ways they can show kindness to someone who seems like an enemy.



##### **AT DINNER:**

Here are some great discussion starters:

Why is it important to not look at other people as our enemies?

What are some ways we can defend against the real enemy, the devil? (Hint: Ephesians 6:10-18)

Who is someone unkind that you can pray for today?



##### **AT BEDTIME:**

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"So, the words spoken by the prophet came true. He has said, 'I will open my mouth and tell stories. I will speak about things that were hidden since the world was made.'" Matthew 13:35 (NIRV)



##### **PARENT TIME:**

What you need to know:

In our world, we have the mentality that there are good guys and bad guys. Like the ones you see on your movie screen. There is good and evil, but our enemy isn't other people, but the devil and the evil spiritual forces. We have the chance to relearn how to treat other people by looking at the Parable of the Good Samaritan. When our kids struggle with other people, we can take a look at this passage to see how to treat our "enemies" and pray for those who persecute us!
