IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

Why is it important to obey God? God loves us and He blesses us when we are in a close relationship with Him. If we stray and sin, we can go to God for forgiveness, and He will celebrate our return. Matthew 21:28-32 & Luke 15:11-32, Two Parables About Two Sons



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid if there is any sin they have committed that is bothering them. Ask your kid why it's important to ask Jesus for forgiveness.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

Why is it good to obey God even when we don't feel like it?

What can we do when we sin and make a mistake?

What does it take to have a close relationship with God?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"So, the words spoken by the prophet came true. He has said, 'I will open my mouth and tell stories. I will speak about things that were hidden since the world was made.'" Matthew 13:35 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

These two parables are important because they show what happens when we are obedient and disobedient. There are always consequences when we sin. The good news is, that we can always return to God and receive mercy! Encourage your child to obey God. Help them see how much God loves them and how excited He is to have them in His family!
