Matthew 6:33



Honoring God with Our Finances

Trusting God with our finances is an act of faith, acknowledging Him as our provider. By putting God first in our financial decisions, we express gratitude for God's blessings and demonstrate reliance on God's provision. Honoring God in this area of our life opens our hearts to generosity and stewardship, reflecting God as priority.

Proverbs 3:9

"Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce."

This verse encourages us to honor God with our finances by giving Him our best. Prioritizing God means recognizing His provision and offering our resources in gratitude. Honoring Him with our wealth fosters a spirit of generosity, reminding us that everything we have is ultimately His.

Malachi 3:10

"Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do, says the Lord of Heaven's Armies, I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in!"

2 Corinthians 9:7

Matthew 6:24

'What Does the Bible Say About Putting God First?

Putting God first is a key message in the Bible. It means placing God above everything else in our lives, letting Him be our guide in all we do. In Matthew 6:33, Jesus says, "But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you." This verse reminds us that when we focus on God and His ways, He will take care of our needs.

The Bible also tells us to love God with all our heart, soul, and strength (Deuteronomy 6:5). This love isn't just a feeling; it's shown in how we live, in our choices, and in our priorities. When we put God first, it affects how we spend our time, how we treat others, and how we make decisions. For example, in Proverbs 3:5-6, we are encouraged to trust in God rather than relying solely on our own understanding. When we trust and follow Him, He makes our path clear.

Putting God first can mean choosing to pray, read the Bible, and obey His commandments, even when it's hard or when others may not understand. It might mean giving up certain desires or habits that don't honor Him. The Bible assures us that when we live this way, we'll find true peace and purpose. By putting God first, we honor Him and open our lives to His blessings, knowing that He will provide for us in all things.'

WEEK 1 Seek First the Kingdom of God

Introduction

Jesus calls us to seek God's kingdom as our primary pursuit. Putting God first means focusing on His will above our own, trusting that He will meet all of our needs. In a world of temporary pursuits, Jesus reminds us that true fulfillment and security are found only in Him.

The theme verse [Matthew 6:33] emphasizes that our first priority should be God's kingdom and righteousness. When we trust God fully and align our values with His, God promises to provide everything we need. It's a call to reorient our lives toward God's purposes, finding peace in knowing God will take care of us.

The Song For The Week: Take Time to be Holy

DAY 1 January 6

Matthew 6:33

"But seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need."

The Prayer

Lord, You are the Creator of every good and perfect gift in our lives. You love us with an unfailing love. Thank you for the gift of life and for Your sustaining grace. Please forgive me for every time I did not place You first in my thinking and decisions. Help me to prioritize the Kingdom in my life. In Jesus' Name. Amen.

Today I will _____ to put God first.

DAY 2

Luke 12:31

"Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and he will give you everything you need."

Here, Jesus repeats the priority of seeking God's kingdom. It assures us that God is fully aware of our needs and committed to fulfilling them when we prioritize Him. In a life that seeks God first, our desires align with His purposes, creating a life that is both fulfilling and spiritually rich.

The Prayer

Today I thank You for the new mercies You have given me. Please fill my heart with your Spirit and focus my mind on Your will and plans for me today

Day 3

Proverbs 3:6

"Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take."

The Action for the Week

Day 1 January 13

Psalm 56:3

“But when I am afraid, I will put my trust in you.”

In moments of fear, we are invited to turn our trust to God. This verse emphasizes that God is our protector and source of strength. By putting our confidence in Him, even fear loses its grip. Trusting God first shifts our focus from our anxieties to God's enduring faithfulness.

The Prayer

Lord, I know you love me. The Word says I can cast all my cares on You because You care for me. There are times, God, when I am anxious, when I am worried, when I am afraid. In these moments, please allow the Holy Spirit to remind me that You are Omnipresent, Omnipotent and Omniscient. Help me trust You thru my fears. In Jesus' Name. Amen

Day 2

Jeremiah 17:7

“But blessed are those who trust in the Lord and have made the Lord their hope and confidence.”

Day 4

Psalm 62:8

God's Will Over Our Own

Day 5

Luke 22:42

"Lord, if you are willing, please take this cup of suffering away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine."

In His moment of deepest anguish, Jesus exemplified the ultimate act of surrender. By submitting to God's will, even through great suffering, Jesus demonstrated that God's plans are always good. Putting God first involves the courage to trust in His wisdom, even when it challenges our desires.

The Prayer

Lord Jesus was the greatest example of submission and obedience. Help me follow His example and surrender to Your will, even when it is difficult, in Jesus' Name. Amen

John 15:12

Day 5

Romans 12:10

“Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honoring each other.”
