hand signals

CHORUS



Making a “C” with your hand will let the team and MD know you want to do the chorus next.


BRIDGE



Making a “B” with your hand will let the MD know you want to go the bridge next.


VERSE



Making a two (like a “V”) with your hand will let your MD know that you want to go to the verse.


TAG / VAMP



If you want to tag the last line of the song or repeat a small chord progression (vamp), tap index and thumb together a couple times to signal the repeat.

section signals

REPEAT



If you want to repeat the section you're in, point your index finger out to the side and rotate your wrist in circular motion.

section signals

INSTRUMENTAL



If you're looking to create an instrumental moment with no vocals, quickly wiggle your fingers individually as if you were playing the piano.

dynamic signals

BUILD UP



If you want the band to start building up the dynamics of the song, hold your hand out flat, palm up, and push upward multiple times.

dynamic signals

BREAK DOWN



If you want to bring the dynamics of the song down, hold your hand flat, palm down, and push downwards multiple times.

dynamic signals

STOP SONG / END CLICK



If you're ready for the song to end, make a fist with your hand to signal the end of the song or worship set.

dynamic signals

START / NEXT SONG



If you're coming out of prayer or an exhortation in between songs, stick your thumb out to the side to signal the start of the next song.
