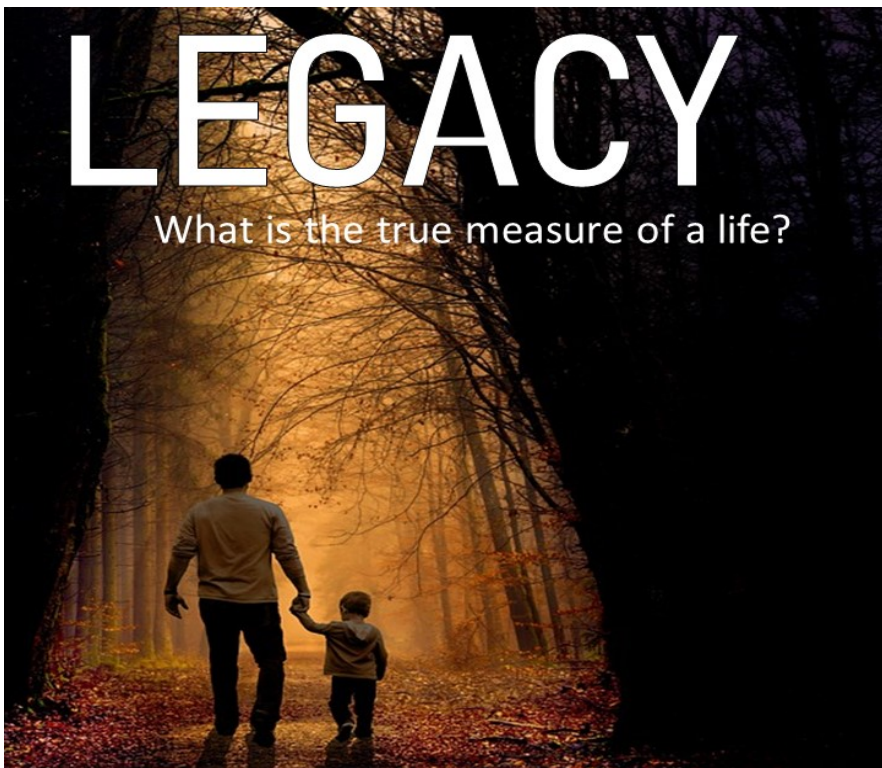

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 11-27-22

CONNECT:

In this week's text we saw David on his deathbed giving his son some final words of wisdom. With that being said, share with the group the best or the funniest advice on life that you've been given. Where did that advice come from and why does it stand out to you?

GROW:

- What stood out the most to you from this week's text or message and why?
- What things do you hope people will remember you for at the conclusion of your life? What changes would you need to make now to see that hope become a reality?
- If you were to write down your last words to a loved one, what thoughts, ideas, truths, or priorities would you have to include and why?
- When we really appreciate the fact that life is brief at best, a second becomes a precious thing. What have been typical "time wasters" in your life? What would Biblical "balance" look like in these areas?

SERVE:

Consider ways to serve someone in your Life Group this week or how your Life Group can serve someone else this week.

MULTIPLY:

What is one practical thing you can do this week to position yourself, at whatever age you are, to finish your one life well? How can you help someone else accomplish the same goal? How can your Life Group help you in this?

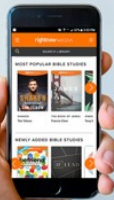
