

# Sermon **NOTES**

## LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 2-15-26

### CONNECT

Paul talks about the importance of shared experience to foster genuine affection between people. Share a story of a time when you did something with a group of people and that shared experience bound you together in a significant way. What did you learn from that?

### GROW

- What stood out to you the most this week from the service, text, or message and why?
- It is clear from this text that Paul developed a genuine love for these new believers in the short time they were together. What type of things foster genuine love among a group of Christians and how can both the church and the individual Christian foster these?
- Paul says that Satan hindered them from returning to Thessalonica. How do you make sense of Satan's efforts to oppose Christians to keep them from doing the good things they desire to do and the ultimate sovereignty of God that can never be decisively opposed?
- What is the most Biblical counsel you've ever been given for discerning God's will for your life and how has it helped you when your plans don't seem to be working out?
