Romans 3:1-8

The guilty rarely want to admit their guilt. It's natural to want to blame someone else for our actions or to argue that we shouldn't be held accountable for our choices.

We want to question God and hold Him to the light of judgement rather than allow ourselves to be judged by Him.

The problem with that is this - our God will always be true to Himself no matter what we believe or do, and His way will always prevail.

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 2-26-23

CONNECT:

What is your earliest memory of church? What was your family's religious practices and how did those practices shape your own religious beliefs and practices?

GROW:

- What part of this week's text or message stood out to you the most and why?
- Paul is clear that objective spiritual and moral truths exist in the world (Romans 3:3-4). How would you defend that statement to a person who believes that spiritual and moral truths are relative? What aspects of life is relativism never tolerated and why?
- Does the reality of sin in the world make God unfaithful, why or why not? Why do you think God created a system in Genesis 2-3 that even allowed for the possibility of sin?
- Some would argue that if God can use sin to bring glory to Himself, then we shouldn't be held responsible for our sin. How does God, who is not the author of sin, bring good from sin? How have you seen Him bring good out of bad in your life?

SERVE:

Consider ways to serve someone in your Life Group this week or how your Life Group can serve someone else this week.

MULTIPLY:

What is one practical thing you can do this week to walk more faithfully with God? How can your Life Group help you in this?

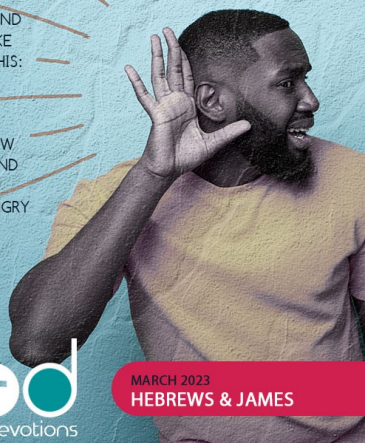

What is the BCTC?

Track #1 of the Biblical Counseling Training Conference equips Christians through virtual training to skillfully, confidently, and lovingly minister God's Word to those looking for answers.

Isn't this just for "Counselors"?

This track equips all learners with the basic tools and knowledge necessary to minister the Word personally. Many will find this training helpful in their individual relationship with Jesus, their own relationships, and in their ministry to others.

Do I have to be a member of Breesport Baptist to attend?

No. We are offering this opportunity to our community at large.

Where is it held?

Classes will be held here at the church. If you prefer, you can choose to watch at home, but watching in community with others here at Breesport will be helpful. Classes are held on 3 weekends: March 24-25, April 28-29, and May 19-20.

How much does it cost?
