

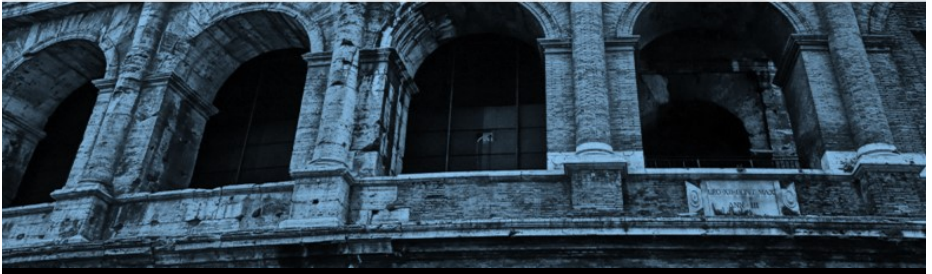

THE CONDEMNATION OF THE MORAL MAN Romans 2:1-11

Have you ever met a hypocrite and thought to yourself, “I want to be just like them”? Probably not.

Hypocrisy is almost universally despised and yet we can all play the part from time to time.

In this week’s passage the apostle Paul is going to warn the moralist against the hypocritical judgement of others. The reality is that even if our morals make us distinct from the culture at large, they never place us above it, and they certainly cannot save us.

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 2-5-23

CONNECT:

The apostle Paul talks about the kindness of God in our text this week. How have you experienced the kindness of God to you this past year? What does the evidence of His kindness to you produce in you and why?

GROW:

- What part of this week's text or message stood out to you the most and why?
- How would you respond to the statement, "Christians aren't supposed to judge others"? What Biblical criteria must a Christ-follower bear in mind when making judgements concerning others?
- From your perspective is it easier for someone to appreciate the grace of God if they grew up in a Christian home or if they got saved later in life and why? What truths or habits can help us be more grateful and mindful of the grace of God?
- In Romans 2:8 Paul says that the paycheck for living in a self-seeking way is wrath and fury. That's a sobering statement. What does "self-seeking" often look like? What is the Gospel counterpoint to self-seeking and what can that look like in your marriage, work, or church life right now?

SERVE:

Consider ways to serve someone in your Life Group this week or how your Life Group can serve someone else this week.

MULTIPLY:

What is one practical thing you can do this week more faithfully model Christlikeness through kindness and patience with others? How can your Life Group help you in this?
