### CONNECT:

- How could you use this passage to help someone who believed that their sin made salvation impossible or who, through self-harm, punished themselves for their sin?

- Justification, redemption, and propitiation are spectacular truths of the Christian faith. How would you define them in your own words? Which one causes your heart to rejoice the most and why?

### SERVE:

Consider ways to serve someone in your Life Group this week or how your Life Group can serve someone else this week.

### MULTIPLY:

What is one practical thing you can do this week to respond to the gift of grace that God has given you through Christ? How can you help someone else understand and respond to these great truths? How can your Life Group be helpful to you in this?


### **REGISTRATION COSTS**
