CONNECT:

Have you ever found yourself in a cross-cultural environment on a mission trip, a work trip, or a family trip? What surprised you about that circumstance and what was your biggest take away from it and why?

GROW:

- What part of this week's text or message stood out to you the most and why?
- The Great Commission is to glorify God by making disciples of Christ through evangelism and discipleship to the ends of the earth. What, in your mind, is harder – evangelism or discipleship and why? How are you presently involved in both?
- Statistically some 4000 local churches close every year in the U.S. and most church plants will close within five years of their founding. Why do you think that's true? Given the fact that America is the fourth largest unchurched nation on the planet, it would seem like fertile ground for church planting. What obstacles make church planting difficult? What can be done to overcome those obstacles?
- What inspires you the most about what God is doing in other places on the earth? Do you think God has moved on from the U.S. – why or why not?

MULTIPLY:

What is one practical thing that you can do this week to be a more effective missionary where God has planted you? How can your Life Group help you in this?
