CONNECT:

Have you ever found yourself in a cross-cultural environment on a mission trip, a work trip, or a family trip? What surprised you about that circumstance and what was your biggest take away from it and why?

GROW:

- What part of this week's text or message stood out to you the most and why?

What can be done to overcome those obstacles?
- What inspires you the most about what God is doing in other places on the earth? Do you think God has moved on from the U.S. why or why not?
