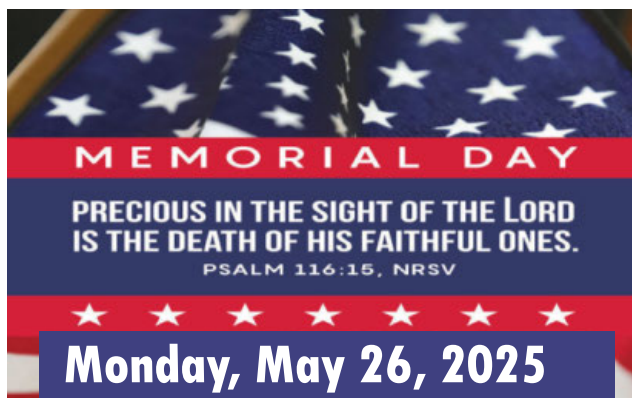

Trinity 8th Grade Graduation

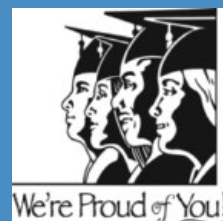
Our Trinitty eighth grade graduation will take place on Wednesday, May 21st at 6:30 PM.

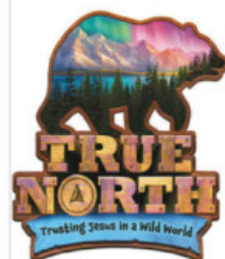
Powerful Tools for Caregivers w/ ADRC
