



Join the Expanding Connection Book Club for a Zoom discussion of, "Everywhere You Look" with the author, Tim Soerens.

Everywhere You Look examines why the emerging generation is opting out of the church in large numbers. Are they dismayed at what appears to be their options for participation? Is church really necessary anymore?

Tim Soerens sees this unsettled state of affairs as an extraordinary opportunity: the church, he says, is on the edge of a new possibility at the very moment so much of it feels like it's falling apart. In his extensive travels in all kinds of neighborhoods, Soerens has seen the beginnings of this movement firsthand.

## AUTHOR, ENCOURAGER TIM SOERENS TO LEAD SEMINARS

The church today faces significant challenges: division, disconnection, and displacement. Even in the midst of these difficulties, we can see God at work, renewing a truly local church—starting right where we are.

If you are looking for some ideas and a boost of encouragement, join us on January 14-15 to hear from Tim Soerens, pastor, author and co-founding director of the Parish Collective. Tim is a leader in a global movement helping Christians “connect to be the Church in the neighborhood.” He has spearheaded sold-out gatherings like the Inhabit Conference, New Parish Conference UK, and Conspire Gathering. Additionally, he co-founded Neighborhood Economics, a venture with the mission to recruit and convene the people repairing local economies.

A gifted speaker and storyteller, Tim has inspired churches across the U.S., Canada, the U.K., Australia, and New Zealand. His teaching focuses on connecting people to be the church in their neighborhoods, celebrating ordinary heroes, and creating opportunities for learning and shared inspiration through gatherings and communities. As part of this event, a panel of neighborhood leaders will join Tim to share their stories and insights.
