**Getting Started**

**Pacing Your Group**

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

**Scripture Reading**

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

**Observation: *What does the scripture say? Read Psalm 51.***

1. King David wrote this psalm after God confronted him over his sins (adultery, murder, lying). What does it tell us about how David responded to God? How did he feel?
2. What does David reveal about how he thought about his sin? About God? About the future?

**Read 2 Corinthians 7:8-11.**

3. How did the Christians in Corinth respond to Paul's "harsh" letter confronting them over sin? How did they feel?
4. What was the result of their brokenness over sin?

**Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?***

5. Paul says there is a difference between "worldly" and "godly" sorrow. What are those differences? How have you experienced them?
6. Can we be fooled into thinking we have godly sorrow when in fact it is worldly? If so, how does that happen?
7. How can we choose godly sorrow? Why might that be difficult?

**Application: *What is God saying to you?***

8. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
