On Sunday, March 15, we'll hold a special installation worship service for Pastor Dom at 4p. This will replace the regularly scheduled morning worship service that day. After worship, we'll have a potluck meal in the gathering center. As we welcome this family, we plan to offer them a housewarming gift with plenty of pantry items to get them off to a good start here. We'll need your help with this. In the coming weeks, we'll begin to share ways for you to be involved with the housewarming gift and installation potluck.

ASH WEDNESDAY MEAL & WORSHIP The season of Lent will begin on Ash Wednesday (February 18 this year) with a special dinner (at 5:45p) and worship (at 6:30p). Donations of soup, salad or dessert are needed – there's a sign-up sheet in the entryway for that purpose. Our observation of Lent will continue on the Sundays in Lent leading up to Easter (April 5). The overall theme for our worship and messages in Lent is "It is Finished." This Lenten series takes worshipers through ten of Zechariah's prophecies, particularly as they relate to the events of Jesus' Holy Week passion, death, and resurrection, and what Jesus' fulfillment of those prophecies means for God's people—now and in eternity. There will also be a special worship opportunity on Good Friday (April 3). Details of this service will be shared mid-March.
