### GENESIS 3:1-6



# LEADER GUIDE

### **Application Answer #1**

Recognize subtle doubts (e.g., “Is God really good here?” or “Did God actually say...?” in culture/media). Stop by quoting the exact verse aloud and refusing to add/subtract. Family application: Create a habit of saying “What does God actually say?” when questions arise.

---

### **Application Answer #2**

In verses 4–5, Satan lies (“Ye shall not surely die”) and appeals to becoming “as gods.” Where do we see the temptation to be our own god (deciding right and wrong ourselves) in family decisions, media, or personal choices?

---

### **Application Answer #3**

Lust of flesh (food, comfort, pleasure), eyes (coveting what looks good), pride (wanting to feel smart/superior). Share honest family examples (e.g., overeating, scrolling envy, arguing to be right). This matches 1 John 2:16 KJV.

---

### **Application Answer #4**

Submit to God daily (prayer, family Bible time), resist by speaking exact Scripture (memorize key verses), and flee temptation together. Family ideas: accountability (“What temptation did you face today?”), turn off triggers immediately, pray aloud when tempted.

---

### **Application Answer #5**

Pause before deciding (pray, recall the verse), obey the first time, confess quickly if we fail. One step: Choose a family verse to quote when tempted (e.g., Psalm 119:11 KJV or James 4:7 KJV).
