# February 2026 PRAYER POINTS

## PREPARING YOURSELF TO PRAY (8 Minutes)

### Confession

*"Come, let's settle this," says the Lord. "Though your sins are scarlet, they will be as white as snow; though they are crimson red, they will be like wool." Isaiah 1:18*

- Lord Jesus, we thank you for settling this once and for all for us at the cross when you died for our sins. We confess our sins to You now.
- Jesus, we thank You that we are forgiven of our sins and we are made as white as snow.

### Surrender

*"I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." Galatians 2:20*

- Jesus, thank You that when you saved me, You came to live within my life. Thank You, Jesus, that on that day I died to myself as Jesus began to live in me.
- Oh Jesus, by faith in Jesus alone, I surrender 100% of my life to You because You loved me and gave Yourself for me.

## PRAYER POINTS AND GUIDE FOR FEBRUARY (20 Minutes)

**Prayer Point 1: Lord, please convict our church to come TOGETHER in unity, forgive one another, and go forward TOGETHER now.**

*"Put on compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another if anyone has a grievance against one another. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you are also to forgive." Colossians 3:12-13*

- Father, You are calling us to compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another, so Lord break us, humble us, and convict us as a church to live as Jesus desires.
- Holy Spirit, convict us to forgive one another just as the Lord Jesus has forgiven each of us.
- God, guide us to make things right with every person and restore our relationships with one another, putting on love, which is the perfect bond of unity.
- Jesus, move us forward **TOGETHER** now, as only You can.



**Prayer Point 2: Jesus, Your church is an Acts 1:8 church: Reaching Metro Fort Smith, Arkansas, America, and the World.**

*"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8*

- Lord Jesus, Acts 1:8 shares Your final words before You ascended to heaven, so we may know this is Your vision for Your church. Please help us to be an Acts 1:8 church.
- Oh God, may Acts 1:8 become our vision, because this is Jesus' vision for our church: Reaching Metro Fort Smith, Arkansas, America, and the World.
- Holy Spirit, Jesus said we will become His witnesses to a lost, hopeless, and dying world, so fill us with the Spirit so that we will be Your witnesses.
- Lord, may we begin to see lost adults of all ages, lost college students, lost teenagers, and lost children come to faith and trust in Jesus Christ.
- Father, we also pray for these upcoming mission trips to reach lost people for Jesus and change the lives of those going: Honduras, February 7-14; Honduras, February 15-21; and to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, which will be our College Students on Mission.

**Prayer Point 3: Father, as we change our entire Sunday Morning Schedule beginning on February 15, may You use it to build and grow Your church here at Grand Avenue Baptist.**

*"Not neglecting to gather **TOGETHER**, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging each other, and all the more as you see the day approaching." Hebrews 10:25*

- Lord, bless our new Sunday Morning Schedule in a great way: Community Groups at 9:15 AM and Worship Service at 10:30 AM.
- Lord, lead our Community Groups to contact all of our members to begin joining our groups weekly at 9:15 AM and our Worship Service weekly at 10:30 AM.
- Lord, may this change be more welcoming to a greater number of guests and younger families, enrich our worship **TOGETHER**, and build our fellowship **TOGETHER** following the worship service.
- Lord, we need teams of people serving in our parking areas and at all doors into our worship center, and creating a great first impression of our church weekly.

**Prayer Point 4: Lord Jesus, we pray that God will change and shape the lives of our Disciple Now for Students from February 27 to March 1.**

*"For I know the plans I have for you"--this is the Lord's declaration--"plans for your well-being, not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope." Jeremiah 29:11*

- God, call a great number of teenagers to this Disciple Now weekend, changing the lives of those who need to be saved, and shaping the lives of those who are already following Jesus.
- Lord, give our student pastor, A.J. Popa, and his team leading this effort the touch of the Holy Spirit, and also anoint with Your Spirit the band "River Valley Collective" and our Speaker, Bryant Forshee.
- God, raise up our student ministry to impact the future of our church in a God-sized way.

**Prayer Point 5: Father, bring hundreds of men to our MEN'S NIGHT on Sunday, MARCH 15, and impact them greatly.**

*"Be watchful, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong." 1 Corinthians 16:13*

- Holy Spirit, draw hundreds of men to our Men's Night.
- Jesus, please call lost men to follow Jesus as Lord and Savior.
- Father, build Christ-following men who walk closely with Jesus, live holy lives, and lead their families with love, courage, and hope.
- Spirit of God, anoint our speakers, Dr. Grant Etheridge and Dr. Nick Floyd, and our Worship Band and Singers from Cross Church, under the leadership of Dr. Julio Arriola. Use our Interim Pastor, Dr. Ronnie Floyd, to lead this initiative.

**Prayer Point 6: Lord Jesus, lead our church into the future You have for us by revitalizing us with a clear, robust vision, fresh energy, and a dynamic move of the Spirit of God upon us.**

*"Without revelation (biblical vision) people run wild, but one who follows divine instruction will be happy."  
Proverbs 29:18*

- Lord, anoint and lead Dr. Ronnie Floyd, our Interim Pastor, as he provides leadership in this season of transition.
- God, we need to be revitalized as a church with a clear, robust vision, fresh energy, and a dynamic move by the Spirit.
- Lord, we know our God will provide for our church's needs, and we pray that we will walk toward the future with faith and hope.
- Father, knowing this, please inspire our people each week to honor God through giving at least the first-tenth of everything the Lord gives them.
