There is a better way to read the Bible!

It's the way Jesus Himself read the Bible on the road to Emmaus, and it's the way the earliest Christians learned to read it, as they saw the entire story of Scripture coming together in Christ.

What happened on the Emmaus road was not “once and done.” It became the pattern in understanding Scripture. It’s how we can – *and should* - read the Bible today.

Today, we'll see how Isaiah's prophecy finds fulfillment in Christ, without flattening the text into a simple "this means that."
