MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings HCC,

I woke up as I typically do in the middle of the night last week, but this time I couldn't get back to sleep. My mind was whirling. I've learned to read my body. I can feel anxiety coming on and when I'm 'next level' anxious, I have a hard time returning to sleep. Sometimes I feel tension in my jaw by the end of the day. That's when it is really bad. Well, my jaw wasn't tight, but I knew I wouldn't be falling back to sleep anytime soon so I headed down to the living room, turned on the light and grabbed my journal.

On page 15 of the "How's Your Soul?" study guide we were given a Weekly Challenge to just be with Jesus in a quiet place for 10 minutes. Well, the Gillman house is pretty quiet at 4:30 AM so I sat down with the Lord and used the prompts given in the Challenge. I also invited the Lord into my thoughts and asked Him, "Why am I anxious?" and "What are your thoughts about my thoughts?". I sat with the Lord and rehashed the circumstances that had triggered my anxiety. As possible answers came to mind, I wrote them in my journal next to my prompts.

In time, the anxiety lessened. As I sat with the Lord I was reminded of his love, his power, and that everything that happens must first pass through his hands. My soul was troubled for a time (I call it a "spot-up shower") but it returned back to being at peace. What happened to change the state of my soul? It returned to God. While I was lying in my bed, my thoughts were whirling, but God was not the main character in the circumstances I was mulling over. When I paused and brought God back into the circumstances my mind was thinking of, things changed.

Pastor Judah Smith asked the question: When is my soul home? The answer? My soul is home when it returns to God.
