STUDY GUIDE: Remember to Pray

Nehemiah 4:1-14

Theme: The Importance of Unity and Diverse Contributions in God's Work

1. When Insulted

- How do you personally react when someone insults or mocks you, especially when you're doing something God has called you to do?
- Why do you think insults often feel heavier when they contain a little bit of truth?
- What are some ways we can respond with prayer instead of reacting in anger?
- When have you seen God do something amazing with "not enough"?

2. When Opponents Plot

- What's the balance between praying and also taking action like Nehemiah did (setting a guard)?
- Have you ever faced someone who got angrier when you stood firm? How did you handle it?
- How hard is staying steady when others are upset at your boundaries?

3. When Feeling Overwhelmed

- What are some signs you're getting tired or discouraged doing God's work?
- How does stress usually affect your decision-making?
- Think of a time when your "habitual response" under pressure helped you—or hurt you.
- What habits of prayer, Scripture, or encouragement could you build now to prepare for future battles?

4. Application

- Where in your life right now do you need to stop reacting or stressing, and pray first?
- What's one specific way you can strengthen your prayer life this week?
