

## **Student Minister Job Description**

### Part Time/Bi-vocational

#### **Qualifications:**

- He must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- He must be called by God to preach His Holy Word.
- He must have a clear calling from God to minister to students and their families.
- He must have a teachable spirit in receiving both direction and correction.
- He must possess these qualities: Integrity, Humility, Passion, Vision, Perseverance, Decisiveness, Purpose-Driven, Good Communicator, Listener, Encourager & Mentor.

#### **Responsibilities to our Students**

- Lead the planning, direction, and supervision of the students in grades 7-12.
- Prepare and teach Wednesday night Bible study for students in grades 7-12.
- Plan and lead annual Youth Bible school, retreats, mission trips and recreational activities in cooperation with the Youth Council (composed of parents and volunteer youth leaders).
- Support any student oriented events that our church supports (i.e. FCA, Fields of Faith, Nehemiah Teams, etc.)
- Seek and implement ways to involve parents whenever possible.
- Plan for student participation in Youth Sunday services (quarterly) in cooperation with our worship staff.
- Seek and implement ways to reach the students in our local schools and community.
- Lead our youth in a way that points them toward Christ our Savior.
- Set an example of faithfulness by attending all worship services along with family, except in uncontrollable circumstances or official vacation days.
- Provide Biblical guidance/counseling referral for youth and parents as needed.
- Supervise all volunteers working with youth.

## **Administration**

- Prepare and present a Youth Ministry budget to our Budget Team for approval at least three weeks before the end of each calendar year.
- Prepare a long-range calendar of events for each year at least three weeks before the end of the church year.
- Add new events to the calendar, as they arise, in a timely manner.
- Report directly to the Senior Pastor and work under his direction and authority and keep the Senior Pastor informed of any ideas for improvements, changes that need to be made, special projects or problems.
- Attend monthly staff meetings.
