HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY

There are many things in life that are not appreciated at the moment. It takes time for true value to surface. That can be said about our mothers. DEVOTION - She's praised because she is first devoted to God. All of her virtuous qualities are founded on her devotion to the Lord.
