But in no time the people turned against Jesus when there was a possibility that their own lives were going to be disrupted because Jesus was not going to be the type of king that they expected Him to be.

In the Old Testament, we read about a man named Job who was not only the greatest man in the land, he was blessed with family, friends, wealth and favor. Then in the span of only a couple of hours he lost it all. Through the good times and the bad times Job chose to praise God. When his world fell apart the bible tells us Job's reaction.

Then he fell to the ground in worship and said: "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked I will depart. The LORD gave and the LORD has taken away; may the name of the LORD be praised." Job 1:20-21

Job was not a fair weather fan. He loved God no matter what the circumstances. Can we be as faithful as Job? Can we love God just as much when times are hard as we do when everything is going great? Consider this, God is not a fair weather fan. His love never wavers for you during your greatest moments or when you are in the depths of sin. I have heard a lot about the patience of Job. But what about his faithfulness?
