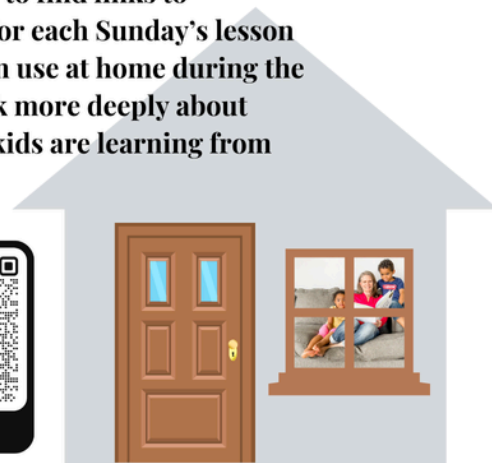
## Discipleship Tools for Your Family

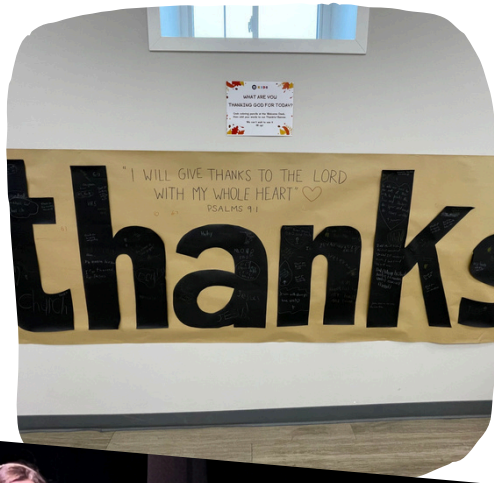
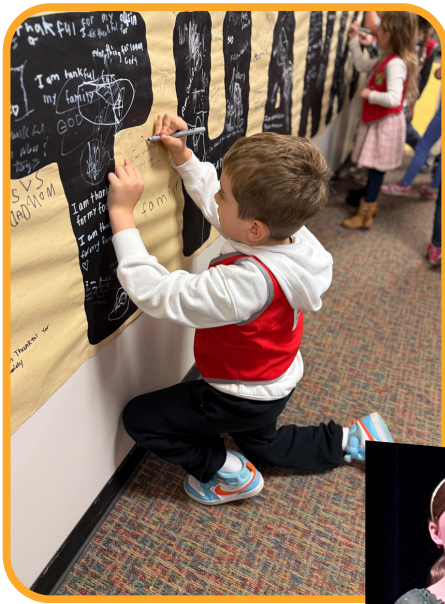
