A SUNDAY AFTERNOON RIDE
(MATTHEW 21:1-11)

This is an important part of His public offer of Himself to Israel as their promised Messiah.

III. His Ride Was a Painful Ride (Luke 19:39-44)

- A. It was Painful Because of His Enemies (39-40)
- B. It was Painful Because of His Emotions (41-44)
