These last months have flown by!!

First of all, I hope you had a blessed holiday season, and I pray that this 2026 is filled with joy, blessing, protection, and a deeper communion with Jesus! 😊

Before getting into any work updates, I want to thank you so much for keeping my mom in your prayers. She received the results from her exams, and the doctors said she is totally healed from cancer, which is a miracle!!



As I shared before, over the past months I have been covering the campus with two other people. This means we help with decision-making, making sure our teams are functioning well, that there is food on the tables for the missionaries, that ministries are running smoothly, and that projects are moving forward.

I also took on the leadership of the open meeting we run every Monday evening. The heart of it is to come together as a community—including locals who aren't part of YWAM—to worship Jesus and receive input that helps us keep growing in our walk with Him.

Back in November, I went to Tirana, Albania for a week to connect with churches and the YWAM campus there. I also did some scouting to get a better gauge of where there are good places for evangelism and to better understand what the spiritual atmosphere is like. It's a city we are committed to sending short-term teams to for the foreseeable future, so we want to keep strengthening our connection with the local church as well as building new ones!





Another exciting update is that after about a year of looking for a new hospitality/staff house, we finally found one! After heaps of prayer, fasting, fundraising, and going back and forth with the bank, we got a loan and were able to purchase it!!! We moved in back in December, and because of that, pretty much all our staff shuffled housing. I moved into a house with four other guys where some of the girls used to live before. The house had a few things that needed to be done, but slowly we have been fixing it up and furnishing it—it's been an enjoyable journey.






Starting in January, we changed our schedule to allow for more outward ministry during the week. Instead of only doing two hours of evangelism a week, we now dedicate the whole Wednesday to ministry. We've split up into groups:

- Homeless ministry
- House visits, community development, and language tutoring
- Strategy team (mapping the neighborhood, identifying cultures and languages present, understanding community needs, and identifying main religions and strongholds)
- Women's ministry (going to the main hotspot of prostitution and abuse in Paris to intercede and talk with the women)

We are very excited for this new season, where we can be even more invested in the land and continue bringing the gospel to the lowliest places. Please pray that we can keep impacting this city with the love of Christ, and for more full-time missionaries to come and be part of these ministries. In total, we are around 45 people carrying all these ministries, in addition to the schools and seminars we run throughout the year.

It has been a very fun and exciting season, and I am really looking forward to seeing what's to come for this city and the other nine cities we are targeting.



For this next season, I will continue leading the campus, running our open meeting, and moving forward with our summer outreach. Through this outreach, we hope to see 100+ international missionaries trained and mobilized to reach Paris.

I will be traveling to California and Mexico between April 15th and May 8th. I'll first be in Huntington Beach to join a YWAM leaders gathering focused on becoming more effective in our ministries and tracking our impact more clearly. After that, I'll spend a few days visiting family, friends, and my church, and then travel to Mexico to be with family there for a few days. I'm very excited to see you again in person. :)

Needs

With all the moving and travel, as well as the exchange rate dropping, it has been a financial stretch. With that in mind, I'd like to:

1. Invite you to pray about joining my monthly support team with \$110 USD per month. I am currently \$800 away from my monthly goal, which would allow me to cover my needs and remain sustainable in missions long-term.

 - USA/MEX flights: \$1,000
