## How is the Pantry?

With so many projects well underway we have been busy updating you on all the new projects. We also never want to forget to keep you informed of the great things still happening in our pantry.

Valley Mission is still serving around 160 household each week. Of these 180, 200 are new families who have never used our services before.

In addition to good quality food our guests receive onsite medical attention, nutrition and meal planning classes, connection to other low-income resources and encouragement.



We make it a priority that our guests would leave feeling joy, hope and a sense of community. Through every aspect of how our pantry operates we strive to make sure that the guests are our central focus. We hope that each guests leaves feeling seen and heard. We pray that as they make the food choices that are best for their families and interact with our team they leave knowing that they are deeply cared for.
